Arizona Strategic Enterprise Technology Update

- Required to submit Updated Strategic and Operational Plans to ONC by June 8th 2012
- Must incorporate responses to two different Program Information Notices (PIN)
- 1st PIN issued February 8, 2012 to address phasing and sustainability
- 2nd PIN Issued March 22, 2012 to address Privacy and Security Framework Requirements
- ASET is using consultant support (Mosaica Partners) to flesh out responses and update plans
- Will report out work product at each Arizona Health-e Connection Board Meeting
 - Draft to PIN in early May; send to ONC; then redline edit of SOP due in July/August

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- ASET is responding to 1st PIN issued February 8, 2012 to address:
- Phasing strongly focused on enabling Stage 1 MU requirements for this year
- Sustainability:
 - Two types of sustainability
 - Coordination with state Medicaid and health reform increase demand for information and business case for exchange across policy and purchasing levers
 - Business viability of any services HIE funds are being provided to ensure that the services deliver value, are in demand and are affordable can fill gaps in the market and are easily adopted and used by providers
- Evaluation: 2% set aside in budget for formal evaluation of ONC HIE program in Az
- Tracking Program Progress: Set goals and track progress for each of the three core HIE program requirements, care summary exchange, lab exchange and e-prescribing as well as for public health reporting

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- 2nd PIN issued by ONC on March 22, 2012 to address:
- Privacy and Security Framework Requirements and Guidance for state HIE programs
- Review existing privacy and security policies and practices to identify where the recipients approach aligns with the specific guidance provided for each domain and where gaps exist
 - 1. Individual Access
 - 2. Correction
 - 3. Openness and transparency
 - 4. Individual choice (not listed in your note below)
 - 5. Collection, use and disclosure limitation
 - 6. Data quality and integrity
 - 7. Safeguards
 - 8. Accountability

- Support Policy Forums/white papers for Development and Collaboration of Issues where gaps identified thru PINS
- More outreach and education to providers and consumers
- More public health/Meaningful use Stage 2 development work
 - Roadmap to get to CORE public health measures
